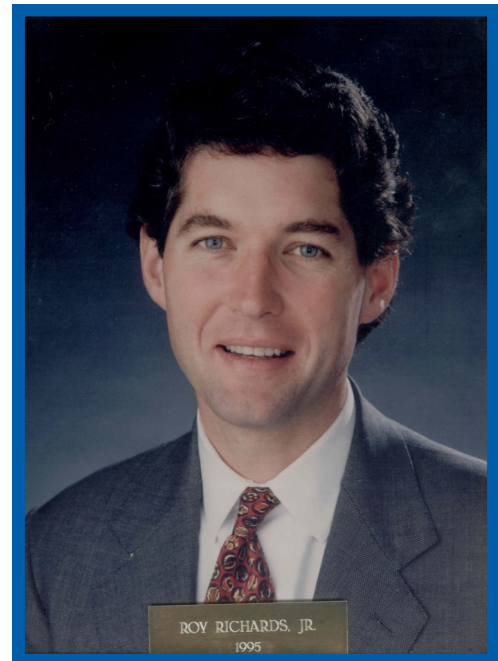


Robert (Bob) E. Myers
