



Graduate Studies Programs

The Graduate Studies Programs value and respect the intellectuality and diversity that out-of-state students bring to campus. In order to encourage these students to attend, a limited number of out-of-state tuition waivers are available to graduate studies. These waivers offer the in-state rate to our out-of-state students as an incentive to attend. **Eligible graduate students must be accepted to the University to be considered.** Decisions will be made with a holistic perception based on submitted materials, academic credentials, and recommendation from perspective Department Program Coordinators/Advisors.

Criteria for Consideration:

- Written Statement (of no more than one page) – detailing why the student should receive out-of-state tuition waiver.
- **If applicable to your program**, a score of 480 or higher on the GMAT, or a score of 450 or higher on the Verbal and Quantitative sections of the GRE or a score of 150 on the revised Verbal section of the GRE, and a score of 141 on the revised Quantitative section of the GRE.
- A minimum grade point average of 3.5 or higher. **NOTE: Student must maintain grade point average to retain waiver.**

Student should submit the above documentation to the Director of Graduate Studies in the appropriate College/School by: **(If deadline date falls on a weekend/holiday documents are due the next business day).**
