BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION MINOR

- Fall 1: ACCT 2101 - Principles of Accounting I
- Spring 1: ECON 2105 or ECON 2106
- Fall 2: MGNT 3600 - Principles of Management
- Spring 2: MKTG 3803 - Principles of Marketing
- Fall 3: 3000/4000 Level Business Elective (Student's Choice)

- To enroll in upper-level (3000/4000) business courses, a student must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 and must have completed at least 45 credit hours.
- Student can take ACCT 2101 and ECON 2105/2106 during the same semester. Student can also take MGNT 3600 and MKTG 3803 during the same semester. Students cannot take MGNT 4660 Strategic Management as their elective choice for a business minor.
