October 16th Faculty Senate meeting: No-confidence resolution

At the October 16th Faculty Senate meeting, the Faculty Senate meeting voted by 32-14 (with 5 abstentions) to adopt the following resolution: "The Faculty Senate, as the representative body of the faculty of the University of West Georgia, declares that it has no confidence in the leadership of President Brendan Kelly." A recording of that Faculty Senate meeting is available online, and I would encourage you to listen to the recording to hear the discussion that preceded this vote. An electronic vote (which will be secure and completely anonymous) of the general faculty on the no-confidence resolution will take place from November 2 through November 9. The 512 full-time faculty members eligible to vote in this election will receive links to an electronic ballot on November 2.

Other Faculty Senate news from the October 16th meeting

The Faculty Senate voted to move student evaluations of instruction (SEIs) online for the fall 2020 semester, as was the case for the spring 2020 semester.

The Teaching, Learning, and Assessment (TLA) Committee is conducting a faculty survey about possible revisions to the questions on our current SEIs, and all faculty are encouraged to participate. For more information, please contact TLA Committee chair Rebecca Gault.

Faculty Development Committee (FDC) chair Mark Faucette reported that the provost informed the FDC that there have been no changes to the university's faculty leave policy and that, contrary to what some faculty had believed, it is still the case that more than one faculty member per department can apply for leave in any given year.

The Faculty Senate also approved new course additions and / or program changes in ANTH, ASTR, CEPD, CRIM, NUTR, and SJUS, and approved a proposed modification to the evaluation of departmental leaders. The Faculty Senate voted on a motion to make the president of the UWG chapter of the AAUP an ex officio member of the Faculty Senate Executive Committee, but because this requires a change to the By-Laws, it will need to be put to a general faculty vote, most likely in November or December.
