## Meeting Agenda Items

5. Revisions for Senate Reapportionment

Duly elected senators will be apportioned to each college, the School of Nursing, and the Library such so that the number of senators allocated to each of the above mentioned units shall equal $10 \%$ of their full-time faculty. The Library, the School of Mass Communications, and the School of Nursing shall elect their senators at large. In regards to the colleges, each department within a college will elect one senator. The remaining senators which have been allocated to that college will be elected at-large by the college. Should any department fail to elect a senator in an election cycle for which it has a vacancy, that vacancy will be added to the at-large pool for its college for that election.

Explanation: This will mean the following:
CACSI: Contains 206 full-time faculty which will entitle them to 20 Senators.

- They currently have 4 departments. This will mean they will have a senator to represent each department (4 senators) and 16 at-large senators which will equal 20.

College of Business: Contains 60 full-time faculty which will entitle them to 6 Senators.

- They currently have 4 departments. This will mean they will have a senator to represent each department ( 4 senators) and 2 at-large senators which will equal 6.

College of Education: Contains 105 full-time faculty which will entitle them to 10 Senators.

- They currently have 6 departments. This will mean they will have a senator to represent each department ( 6 senators) and 4 at-large senators which will equal 10.

Library: Contains 11 full-time faculty which will entitle them to 1 Senator. (All senators will be considered at-large for that College.)

School of Mass Communication: Contains 15 full-time faculty which will entitle them to 1 Senator. (All senators will be considered at-large for that College.)

Tanner School of Nursing: Contains 32 full-time faculty which will entitle them to 3 Senators. (All senators will be considered at-large for that College.)

University College: Contains 70 full-time faculty which will entitle them to 7 Senators.

- They currently have 2 departments. This will mean they will have a senator to represent each department (2 senators) and 5 at-large senators which will equal 7.

Questions still remaining:

- How we will fill in the holes for the people who are revolving off in 2021?
- CACSI has 7 Senators who end their terms in 2021. With their reduced number of senators by 5 , will they only elect 2 new senators and will we fill in the holes there?
- College of Business has 2 Senators who end their terms in 2021. They retain 6 senators so they will only elect 2 new senators.
- College of Education has 3 Senators who end their terms in 2021. They gain 1 senator to bring their total to 10 senators. That means 4 need to be elected.
- The Library has 1 Senator who ends his term in 2021. They still have one senator whose term does not end until 2022. Does this mean there will be no election for the Library?
- The School of Mass Communications currently has 3 Senators and none who end their term in 2021. How do we reduce their number down to the allocated one senator?
- The Tanner School of Nursing has 1 Senator who ends her term in 2021. They have three senators so they will need to elect a new senator.
- University College currently has 4 senators. No Senators end their terms in 2021. They need to elect 3 new senators to bring their total up to 7 senators.
- Also, don't forget about the Reps.
- Mass Com will need new elections, as will UC.
- CACSI has some committees with 2 reps so you'll need to decide if one moves to another committee or to start over with Rep elections there.
