Susana: Time Limits for Tenure 103.0402

The committee too again this policy that had been reviewed in 2018. This time Rules agreed to include the suggested changes, namely:

- To include the extension of the tenure clock which was in the BOR policy but not in UWG's Faculty Handbook.
- To add to the policy extensions of the pre-tenure, tenure, promotion, and post-tenure review clocks
- For points 2 to 6 we changed the language to include mostly the links to BOR's Policy Manual because our handbook was worded exactly as the BOR's policies.

Proposed Policy for Senate Executive Officers

Rules was tasked by the Executive Committee of the Faculty Senate with reviewing the Policy for Senate Executive Officers. The changes proposed by the Executive Committee are necessary because there's currently no provision in UWG's Policies and Statutes to deal with extended absences of any of the Executive Officers of the Senate.

The Rules Committee discussed the changes and was concerned that the policy proposed was too specific in naming the past officers (Previous Chair, Previous Secretary, and Previous Parliamentarian) as replacement for the current Executive Officers in case of leave. The concerns were mainly:

- That the policy might force some members of the Executive Board to serve longer terms than they anticipated. For instance, in the case of the

Chair of the Faculty Senate they will serve one year as chair-elect, two as chair, and to these a 4 year could be added if a new Senate Chair takes and extended leave of absence.

- That this policy might not be enforceable. That is, that there might not be a way to mandate that the previous executive members serve for another extended term to cover for absences of current executive members.
- That the leave of absence for research (for instance, a sabbatical) is known several months and sometimes years in advance, and that it might be advisable that people who know that a research leave might interfere with their service as executive members of the board should not run for election to these positions.

To address these concerns the Rules Committee decided to modify the policy by removing mention of specific individuals such as the previous Chair, Secretary, and/or Parliamentarian of the Faculty Senate.
