

UWG ITS Telephone Rates and Charges

In FY07, new single line telephone sets and lines in UWG PBX supported buildings will be installed at a flat **one time cost of \$500** which includes the set, the closet phone port, maintenance for the set, a direct inward dial (DID) phone number, and ongoing leased line connectivity to the Public Station Telephone Network. Telephone cabling is an additional onetime cost if not existing. Requests for new Multi-line phone sets will have the additional cost of the price difference between a single and multi-line set. Phone set moves are no charge. Auxiliary equipment like Add-On Modules & headsets will be purchased on a cost recovery basis.

Cable Installation rates are as follows: for installation of a single telephone in a University building where a jack and wiring exists the charge consists of one records charge and a one hour labor minimum (total charge \$0.00). Time and materials charges apply for installations where jacks and wiring do not exist.

Cable, jacks and other materials (a 3 Cat 6 cable outlet install typically runs \$200 to \$300 for materials) varies
