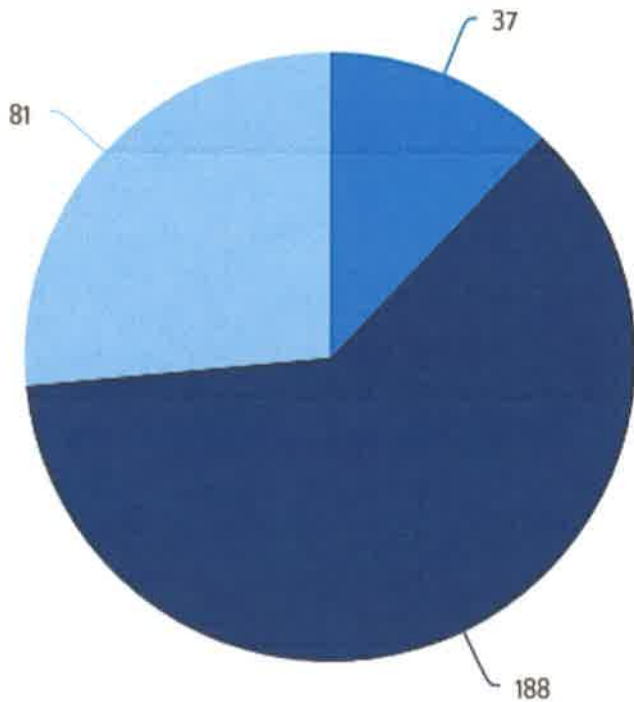


# December 2018 First Destination Survey Report



## Data Collection

For Fall 2018, the Office of Career Services received a total of 306 responses out of 851 graduates, resulting in an overall response rate of 36% for the survey. Data for post graduation outcomes is collected using Qualtrics and distributed electronically to each graduation class. Students are also provided an opportunity to complete the survey in-person at each graduation fair. Follow up surveys are sent to students after graduation intermittently and remaining non-respondents are contacted by phone. Career Services also collects public social media profile data from LinkedIn, Facebook, and other platforms for those students who failed to respond to the online or in-person surveys. The number of responses collected by category are displayed here.

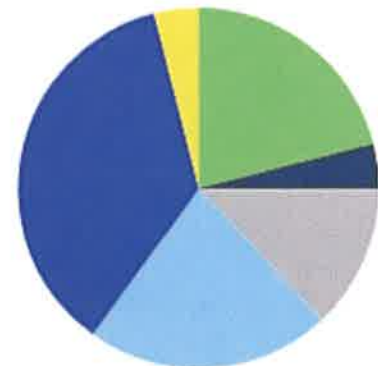

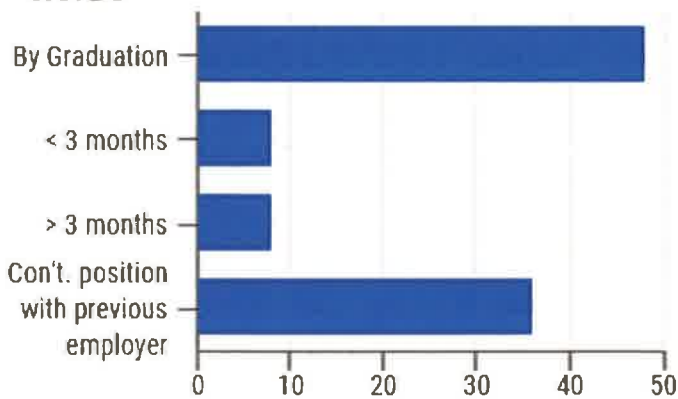

Forty-eight percent (48%) of respondents reported having attained employment at the time of Graduation. Thirty-six percent (36%) continued employment with an existing employer, while 8% were employed within 3 months of graduation. The remaining 8% were employed more than 3 months after graduation.
